
Who is Eligible for Home Health Services?

Home Health can often cost less than traditional hospital or nursing care. To be eligible for Home Health, the patient must:

- Be homebound, or unable to leave their home without some degree of difficulty
- Require skilled care
- Have a referral or prescription for home care from their physician

If you're interested in setting up Home Health services, simply contact your physician, healthcare provider or your local Adventist Health organization. Scheduling of visits will be determined by your physician and the skilled professionals who will be providing home health services.



Team Based Approach

Home Health is made up of a team of skilled professionals who provide excellent care in your home. From the time a referral is made, our intake staff processes and schedules services based on your health care provider's guidance. Our team of skilled staff includes:

Registered and Vocational Nurses

Provide wound and ostomy care, medication management, tube feedings, pain management, diabetic education and catheter care.

Physical Therapists

Provide rehabilitation at home by providing a home safety evaluation and developing a plan of care to help with gait training, strengthening and improving mobility.

Speech Therapists

Provide comprehensive evaluation and treatment of speech, language, voice, swallowing and cognitive disorders.

Occupational Therapists

Instruct to improve independence with assistive devices, energy conservation, personal care and meal preparation.

Medical Social Services

Provide social services at home including emotional needs and counseling for financial and community resources.

Home Health Aides

Help assist with personal care, bathing and dressing.
